



Ladies of the Pointe 2022 Activities

Winter league play occurs from November to March each year.

Official league play begins April 7 and ends October 27. Below is a list of activities during 2022 as of January 1, 2022. List will be updated as needed.

January

5, 19, 26 Nine-hole mentoring play with six tee times beginning at 2pm. This program began during the 2021 season and has returned! Due to course closures on Mondays, mentoring will be held on Wednesdays through March 16 (with a skip of January 12). Eighteen-hole members will mentor interested 9- and 18-hole members for the purpose of getting to know one another to foster better relationships and collaboration while enhancing knowledge of the rules, etiquette, pace of play, course management, etc. Sign up is managed by LOP Board via Tee Time Helper invitations.

February

2, 9, 16, 23 Nine-hole mentoring (Wednesdays)

3 Open Forum— an opportunity for membership to have a questions and answers period with the LOP board on golf related topics. Tad Sander, Compass Pointe Head Golf Professional, will be in attendance to answer any golf related questions. March

2, 9, 16 Nine-hole mentoring (Wednesdays)
